Our original 7 member group, has grown to 23 (as of January 2009) representing a combined membership of almost 4,000 artists statewide. We are very proud of our 6 outreach programs and our 2 new programs being introduced. As an all volunteer organization that continues to grow, the Alliance has many opportunities for new talent, ideas and personal satisfactions. To date (using the State of Arizona guidelines), the Alliance members have contributed more than a million dollars of volunteer time.
