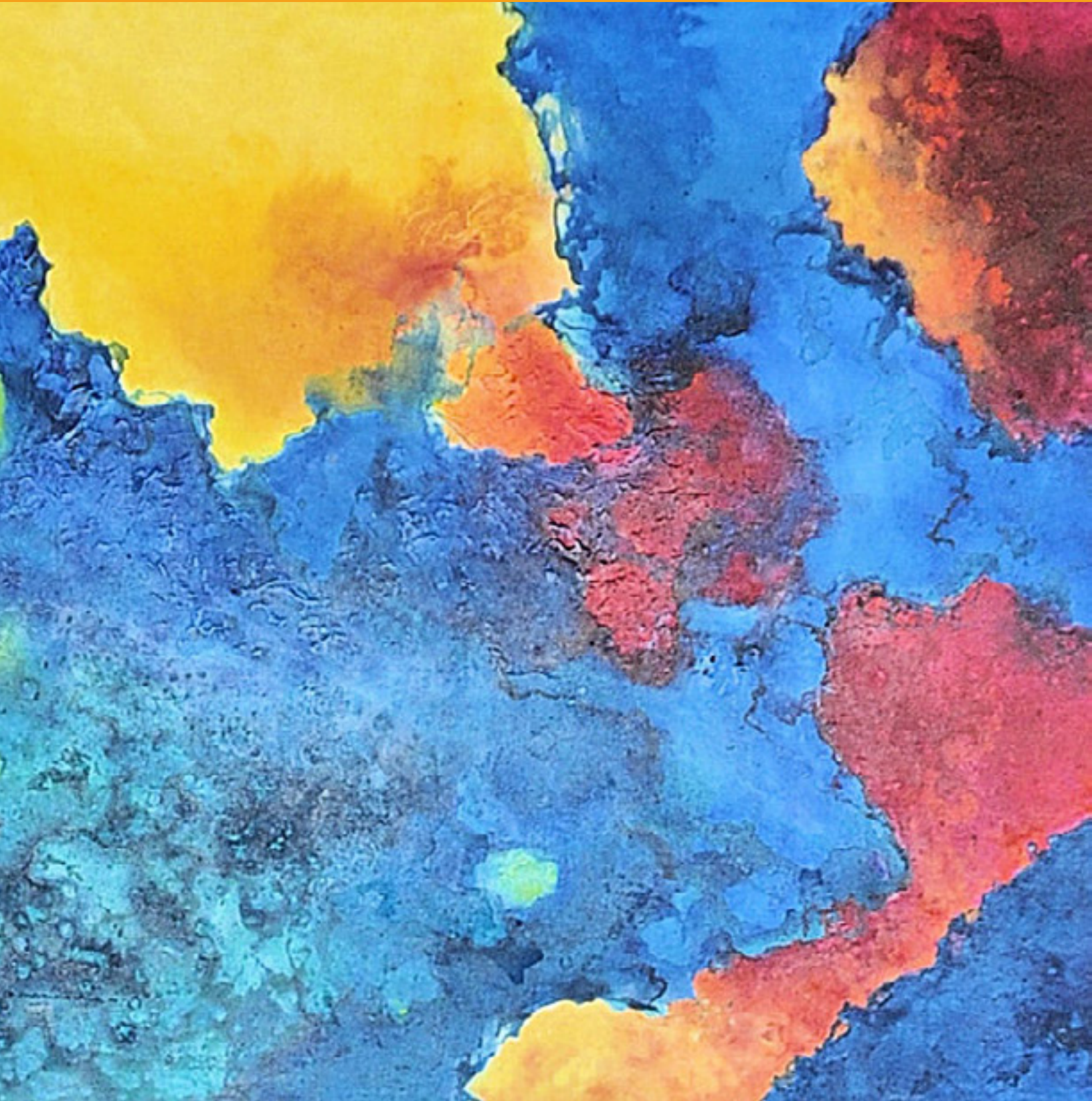

As the summer is upon us, many of our member organization suspend activities until fall.

ARTIST UNVEILS PORTRAIT OF ARIZONA GOVERNOR

July 6, 2011 — Arizona artist Joye DeGoede presented Governor Janice Brewer with her portrait in a private presentation with Governor Brewer, several members of her staff and the artist's family.

Governor Brewer and her staff met with Joye throughout the process for reference photographs and to advise on adjustments to capture the true personality and spirit of the Governor. Joye asked Governor Brewer how she wanted to be remembered in history and Governor's response, as she recalls, was to be remembered as kind, compassionate and a fair person.

Joye met Governor Brewer in 2009 when the artist won the People's Choice award for the Capitol Christmas Tree Art Competition. Joye's painting, 'Passing on the Gift of Nature to Future Generations' is part of the Arizona Governor's permanent collection and is displayed in the Governor's office.

She has created custom art, note cards and stationery for major hotels and resorts.

Certified with an art endorsement, DeGoede has taught art in private and public schools in Arizona for the past 17 years. She also teaches private lessons to aspiring artist young and old who are looking to develop their creative abilities.

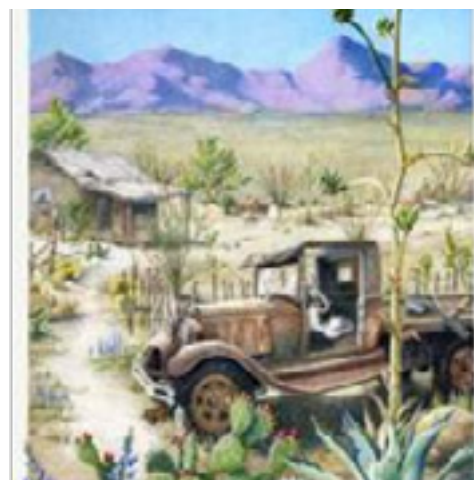

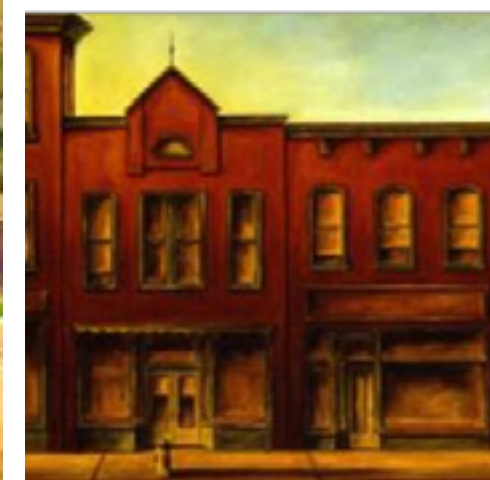

To show in this exhibition the AAA Juried Artist or AAA Group must buy an ad for the next program, which is the December 1st to 23rd Holiday Show at the AAA Gallery. Buying an ad allows the artist or AAA group to show at Courtyard Marriott at no further charge. Full pages in the program measure 5.5 wide X 8.5 inches tall.

Please note: Single artists are allowed one piece at this show. AAA Groups are allowed 2 pieces at this show.

THE HANGING:

Those artists or AAA Groups having paid for their ads by the date stated above can bring their art to the Courtyard Marriott Hotel at 134th Street and Shea Blvd., Scottsdale on Monday, August 29th, 2011 between 9 and 11am. It will be signed in and you will be given a receipt for your work after which you may leave. All show tags, hanging and placement of the art will be conducted by AAA Staff.

AD DELIVERY:

The ad itself must be delivered to the Arizona Art Alliance by October 1st, 2011 on a CD and be print-ready @ 300 dpi or better. This date allows 2 months for program assembly

and delivery to the printers and their return shipment by the commencement of the December Holiday Show. The AAA does not make or furnish the ads but can suggest those that are in the business of making such ads. The ads and their construction costs are the participants responsibility.

BE AWARE: There are only 17 more spaces left in this upcoming 6 month Phase at the Courtyard Marriott. Those interested should act expediently to acquire their space. Once the show has been filled, any paid ads that are over-booked will be held as pre-paid and automatically be set for the AAA Spring Show Program and the following phase at the Courtyard Marriott, the dates of which are February 27th through August 29, 2012.

These ads, of course, do help defer costs for the printing of the several thousand show programs necessary for such special shows as the Holiday and Spring Exhibitions. However, they are also an excellent way to advertise and promote yourself as a working artist or prominent Arizona art group and can turn into art sales.

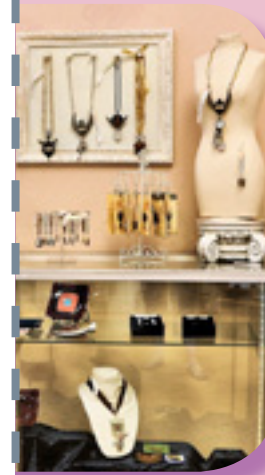

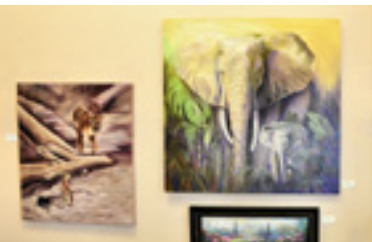
