Arizona Pastel Artists' Association

Featured Artist: Marta Smith



It was in the early 60's when Marta Smith started painting wild animals. She had seen an ad for a lion on a travel poster and he was so majestic and beautiful. After a neighbor bought the painting she decided to try other animals and before long

she was exhibiting in a show at a local mall. At that show she sold all her paintings the first day.

During the next few years it was a busy time with four small children and the only time found to paint was late evenings. She had begun to get requests for pet portraits and found a lucrative business doing so. Many a night she would call it a "three dog night" and at Christmas time people would line up at the door to pick up their portraits. These were all done in pastel, which doesn't need time to dry and she found it easy to work with.

Marta's work won many awards and recognition for Marta. The result was representation by two galleries in Grand Rapids, Michigan. During this time Marta shared her knowledge teaching at the local art school. Highlights of her art career to date include having two postcards of her



animals included in the World Wildlife Fund and being represented by a gallery in Stockholm, Sweden for her work. Marta was born in Sweden and returns there regularly to visit family.

Marta found making a living as an artist hasn't always been easy often experiencing "feast or famine" between shows and commissions. To complicate matters, when Marta relocated to Arizona in the late 80's, she found the art world to be very different from Grand Rapids. Collectors in Arizona weren't buying raccoon or squirrel paintings. She decided to work retail and as a result found herself with little time to paint. Then, in the 90's with a second marriage and more time she decided to take classes in watercolor and oil at local colleges, The Scottsdale Artist School and even a class in Monet's Garden in Giverny. She has been back at the easel ever since.



After experimenting with different mediums Marta has returned to painting with pastels. Marta joined APAA and actively takes advantage of the varied learning opportunities offered through the organization as well as workshops offered through other venues. She is dedicated to learning all she can with new pastel techniques and materials. Now her subject matter includes paintings of people and landscapes and even cars, for which she was excited to win a ribbon in the recent AAA show.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES RECOGNIZES ARTISTS

Visions of Arizona is currently on view from November 4, 2011 – November 2, 2012 at the Arizona House of Representatives on the 2nd floor. This collection of artwork on loan was made possible through the generous volunteer efforts of the [Arizona Art Alliance](http://azartalliance.com), who managed the statewide open call to artists. A review panel convened by the Arizona Commission on the Arts recommended 25 artworks from a juried pool of over 300 submissions. The exhibited artworks were selected in consultation with the House Majority Whip, Representative Debbie Lesko, who recognized the artists by reading their names on the House floor. The Arizona Art Alliance was also given an award for their artistic contribution.

Each year, Robert C. Booker, Executive Director of the Arizona Commission on the Arts, forms a panel of 8 - 10 Arizonans to review the various nominations for the prestigious Governor’s Arts Awards. Mr. Fontana has accepted the invitation to serve and will strive to make a positive contribution to this year’s award process. February Signals the Board of Directors Election Process

The Nominating Committee shall prepare ballot materials: cover letter, if necessary; ballot listing candidate by office, names in alphabetical order, title, and any other data (group affiliation) and candidate statements. This information will be submitted to the Board of Arizona Art Alliance by February 10, 2012 to conduct the electronic election. From the time the ballot is listed and before the February 17, 2012 Board meeting, voting must be completed within seven days. The Nominating Committee chair shall inform each candidate of the elections immediately and thereafter the results shall be posted on the Arizona Art Alliance website.

Changes Already Made in Leadership of the Arizona Art Alliance

As we go into the election process for the Board of Directors and Officers, three important changes are now in effect. Specifically, John Fontana has resigned his position as President, but remains as Chairman of the Board, Deb Sedlmayer has assumed the role of Acting President, until that position is officially filled, and Barbara Hurley-Peterson has resigned from the Board and her position as Grants Director. We sincerely thank Barbara for her outstanding service to our organization and gratefully acknowledge her willingness to provide input for future grant requests. The Arizona Pastel Artists Association was founded by a group of Arizona artists on May 2, 1994 in Phoenix, Arizona. The Association was incorporated in 1997 and was granted 501c4 status in 2011. The APAA is a member of the International Association of Pastel Societies and the Arizona Art Alliance.

The membership currently numbers over 100 and represents pastelists from across both Arizona and the United States. Members range from professional full time artists known nationally and internationally to members just getting interested in learning about the medium of pastel. The organization holds monthly meetings September through May taking a summer recess for the months of June through August. Meetings are typically held the first Sunday of the month at the Arizona Art Guild building. Each meeting includes a general membership meeting as well as a program. Programs may include demos, speakers on the business of art, art critiques, etc. A digital newsletter is sent out monthly throughout the year to enhance communication between members spread widely geographically.

As an organization we seek to inspire and engage our members through a variety of activities. Like many organizations, APAA holds an Artist of the Month competition culminating with an Artist of the Year competition at the end of the meeting year. Three times a year an Art Challenge is initiated. A limited number of members sign up for each Art Challenge. They are given an object or word at a subsequent meeting that they must incorporate into a painting. After two months the participants bring their painting to the meeting and the group has a critique/discussion based on the resulting paintings.

APAA holds two juried membership shows each year, one in the fall and one in the spring. Judges have included well known valley art professional as well as national and international level instructors from across the nation. Locations for the shows have included Sedona, Cottonwood and locations within the valley. APAA also hosts a minimum of two workshops a year, often in conjunction with a show utilizing the instructor as a show judge. These major workshops typically range from 3 to 5 days. However, APAA also offers mini workshops and class series utilizing members and local professionals.

APAA offers three membership levels. Individuals initially join the organization as general members. Earning points through participation in APAA shows allows for members to become juried members. Juried members may continue to earn points through a variety of avenues laid out in the bylaws to earn signature member status. APAA currently has 18 signature members and will be holding its first annual signature member show at the University Club of Phoenix this spring.
